Introduction

The PingFederate SharePoint Server 2007 Integration Kit adds a Service Provider (SP) application-integration option to PingFederate 5 or higher.

The kit includes a SharePoint Server Internet Information Services (IIS) agent that works in conjunction with the PingFederate OpenToken Adapter to allow an SP enterprise to accept SAML assertions and provide SSO to SharePoint Server 2007.
